Major Thomas Henry Hill, an Indian Mutiny veteran and one of the last survivors of the servants of the Honourable East India Company, died in London on Wednesday at the age of 86. He was a boy of thirteen in India when the mutiny broke out, and so great was the demand for medical apprentices at that time that he joined the Indian Medical Department. He spent many years as a medical officer with frontier troops.
